



In-Person Workshop Registration Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where do Officials register for the In-Person Workshops?

A: There is a registration page the "In-Person Workshops" tab on the Officiating Online Learning Center. Officials will register and be confirmed by the USTA Officiating Department (to make sure they are certified and have taken the required courses, if applicable).

Q: Who will be selected for the In-Person Workshops?

A: Registration and selection is on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Q: Can Officials attend an In-Person Workshop in another section?

A: Yes, Officials may register and attend an In-Person Workshop in another Section, but priority will be given to Officials that belong to the Section in which the Workshop is being held. If space is available, they will be given the opportunity to attend the Workshop.

Q: What if an Official is having trouble registering for the In-Person Workshop on the Online Learning Site? Can the USTA Officiating Department register someone for a Workshop if they are unable to do so themselves?

A: The USTA Officiating Department can register an Official for a Workshop if they are not able to do so themselves. The Official will still receive a confirmation email once they are enrolled.

Q: Will the participants be reminded of the In-Person Workshop beforehand?

A: If confirmed for the Workshop, participants will receive a reminder email one week prior to the Workshop date.

Q: What if the minimum number of participants required to hold the Workshop is not met? Will it still be held?

A: The USTA Officiating Department will handle this situation on a case by case basis. The ultimate goal is to hold the Workshop as planned. However, if the Workshop is canceled, the participants will receive a cancelation notification via email.
