

How To Earn Continual Learning Credits

Remember, continual learning credits are part of your annual certification requirements, and there is still plenty of time to earn continual learning credits before October 31st! Any Official who was certified before November 1, 2022, will need to earn 4 continual learning credits in order to recertify for the 2023-24 certification cycle.

ProSteps for earning your continual learning credits!

1. OfficialsFirst - My Certification Tab

- The “Education Credits” section under Core Requirements will let you know how close you are to meeting your continual learning credit goal.

2. Log into the [Officiating LRC](#).

3. Click the “My Dashboard” tab

- This will give you detailed information about your credit earning journey.

OFFICIALS CONTINUAL LEARNING CREDITS

Certification Renewal
The dashboard below displays how many CLCs (Continual Learning Credits) have been earned during the current certification period and how many credits are required to renew your USTA certification(s). The certification period runs from November 1st the previous year to October 31st of the current year, and only courses completed during this date range will appear in the dashboard. Credits displayed below will reset annually on November 1st for the next certification renewal period.





If you became a brand new USTA Official during the current certification cycle (on or after November 1st), you do not need to earn continual learning credits.

4. Click the “My Trainings” tab

- This tab is your full learning history so that you don't retake content you have already completed. Remember, credit will not be earned on content you have completed in the past.

5. Review the [breakdown of credit earning](#) for everything in the LRC
 - a. This can be found on the [Officiating Certification Regulations](#) web page.
6. Find Content that will earn you credits → Click the “Home” Tab
 - a. Disciplines and Courses section
 - i. Courses earn 1 credit each
 - ii. Most of the short items in the Diversity & Inclusion library earn 0.25 credit.
 - b. In-Person Education
 - i. Workshops earn 2 credits
 - c. Webinars
 - i. Check out the “Webinar Recordings” library, the number of credits earned and if it counts towards general or tennis knowledge will be listed with the title.
7. Check the “My Trainings” tab
 - a. Online courses and webinar recordings will show up immediately.
 - b. Workshops and live webinars attendance can take up to a week.
 - c. Once the completion shows up on your My Training tab, it takes 24 hours for your LRC Dashboard to update and can take up to 48 business hours for OfficialsFirst to update.
