

2018 Roland Garros Main Draw Wild Card

MEN'S FACT SHEET

Details:	<p>The USTA will be awarding one (1) men's singles main draw wild card into 2018 Roland Garros based on performance in any professional outdoor clay (Har-Tru or Red) Challenger Tour level events & above in the world. The wild card will be awarded to the American player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles ranking points (both qualifying and main draw) from the events listed during the below weeks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players' best two (2) singles results during a four (4) week time period (weeks of April 9, April 16, April 23 & April 30 - ATP World Tour & Challenger calendar weeks 15, 16, 17 & 18 respectively) will be used and combined to calculate the point total. • In the event of a tie, the player with the best ATP singles ranking in the published ATP rankings on Monday, May 7, 2018 will be awarded the wild card. • Should the player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles points from their best two (2) results become a Direct Acceptance into Roland Garros, the next eligible American player with the highest cumulative ATP singles points from their best two (2) results will be awarded the wild card (ties will be broken as described above). • In the event that issues arise that are not covered by these rules, USTA Player Development will be the final arbiter.
Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players who are USA passport holders and are eligible to represent the United States in Davis Cup competition in 2018 are eligible to be considered for the singles main draw wildcard. • The minimum age for eligibility is 14. There is no maximum age restriction.
