



2020 MEN'S FACT SHEET

Details:	<p>The USTA will be awarding one (1) men's singles main draw wild card into the 2020 Australian Open based on performance in professional indoor and outdoor hard court Challenger Tour level events & above in the world. The wild card will be awarded to the American player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles ranking points from their best two (2) results – including points earned in qualifying and main draw during the below weeks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players' best two (2) singles results, including points earned in qualifying & main draw, from indoor and outdoor hard court Challenger Tour level events & above in the world, except the Next Gen ATP Finals, during a three (3) week time period. Weeks of October 28, November 4, and November 11 will be used and combined to calculate the point total – please find below specific events. • In the event of a tie, the player with the best ATP singles ranking in the published ATP rankings on Monday, November 18, 2019 will be awarded the wild card. • Should the player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles points from their best two (2) results become a Direct Acceptance into the Australian Open, the next eligible American player with the highest cumulative ATP singles points from their best two (2) results will be awarded the wild card (ties will be broken as described above). • In the event that issues arise that are not covered by these rules, USTA Player Development will be the final arbiter.
Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the time of the October 28 published ATP rankings, players ranked within the Top #50 ATP will not be eligible in the Wild Card Challenge. • Players who are USA passport holders and are eligible to represent the United States in Davis Cup competition in 2019 are eligible to be considered for the main draw wild card.
