



MIDDLE STATES RALLY STARS OUT-OF-SCHOOL TIME TENNIS PROGRAM



As a School Partner for your school, USTA Middle States would like to thank you for connecting and providing opportunities for children to play tennis outside of their Physical Education class.

GUIDELINES and REQUIREMENTS to run Middle States Rally Stars Out-of-school time Programs Grades K-12

NET GENERATION REGISTRATION

School Partners must be registered and approved in Net Generation.

Schools must have at least one teacher registered and approved in Net Generation.

- Prior to the start of the program, at least one P.E. teacher from the school must create a Net Generation account and register their PE class on usta.com.
- The Provider and the School have signed a School Partner Agreement.
- The Provider has entered the program in Net Generation's Program Management Center as a Community program.

PROGRAM PLANNING

Providers must complete the [Rally Stars Program Planning Form](#) prior to the start of the program

- Middle States will then provide a registration link if applicable.
- Middle States will provide a registration flyer.

PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION

Providers must submit participant registration information on or before the start date of their program in order to receive Middle States Rally Stars incentives.

Complete student registration one of two ways:

- Use the Provider's own registration system, and then prior to the start of the program, also upload the students' information into the Jotform created for their particular program. Link will be provided by Middle States upon receiving the Rally Stars Program Planning Form.
- Use a link on the Middle States website created for their particular program. Middle States will provide a roster of the students registered prior to the start of the program.
- All programs must have a minimum of ten (10) participants in order to receive program stipends.

CURRICULUM:

Providers must use the Net Generation Community Curricula for their program(s).

- Each site should host a 6-session program.
- Each session should last 60 minutes (minimum) depending on the ages and/or skill level of the students.

FEES and STIPENDS:

We encourage Providers to offer free out-of-school time programming.

- If a Provider decides to charge a fee, program fees cannot exceed \$30 per student for the entire program.
- Providers are responsible for collecting their player registration fees.

All programs must have a minimum of ten (10) participants in order to receive program stipends. Providers are eligible to receive a stipend of \$500 per out-of-school time program per calendar year.

- Providers can receive up to four (4) stipends; two (2) stipends for the same school per calendar year.

COMPETITION: Provider agrees to host a Team Challenge registered in Net Generation. Date of the Team Challenge to be determined after submission of the Program Planning Form.
