

Process: To generate a year-end rating, a player must compete a minimum of 3 times in an Adult and/or Tri-Level league. Players competing exclusively in Mixed 18 & Over and/or Mixed 40 & Over **may** achieve a year-end rating if they participate in 3 or more matches.

Who can be dynamically disqualified? Self-rated players (S), appealed players (A), and players who have already been disqualified in the current ratings period (D)

League Type	Does it count toward year-end ratings?	Can I be disqualified?
Adult 18 & Over Adult 40 & Over Adult 55 & Over	Yes. Dynamic ratings are calculated after each match. If a self-rated or appealed down player grossly overperforms the expectation of the NTRP algorithm, a strike is generated. If a player reaches three strikes*, they are disqualified/promoted to the next NTRP level.	Dynamically - Yes ** By Grievance - Yes
Adult 65 & Over Tri-Level	Yes. There are no post-match dynamics; however, results are included at year-end.	Dynamically - No By Grievance - Yes
Mixed 18 & Over Mixed 40 & Over	Conditional. Yes if a player only participates in the Mixed league type and does not have a valid computer rating OR whose current computer rating will expire at year's end. No if the player participates in the Adult league type and achieves a year-end rating based off those results.	Dynamically - Yes** By Grievance - Yes
Combo Mixed 55 & Over Anything Else	No.	Dynamically - No By Grievance - Yes

* A strike can be generated at any time from local league play through National Championships.

** A player can be dynamically disqualified/promoted through Sectional Championships.
