



NEW Information for USTA League Play in the Chicago District for the 2021 Championship Year

- CDTA will be offering League play at new times. In addition to Weekend play, Weekday and Early Bird leagues will be offered. These offerings will be considered additional Leagues (not Flights); so, Players could play on a Team in the traditional Weekend league AND in the Weekday or Early Bird leagues.
- Teams and clubs participating in the Weekday league must be available for Match play starting between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Monday and Tuesday ONLY.
- Teams and clubs participating in the Early Bird league must be available for Match play starting between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Monday through Friday.
- Teams and clubs participating in the Weekend League must be available for Match play at the following times:
 - Friday - 7:30 p.m. earliest start; 8:00 p.m. latest start
 - Saturday - 9:00 a.m. earliest start; 8:00 p.m. latest start
 - Sunday - 9:00 a.m. earliest start; 7:00 p.m. latest start
- **Regardless of prior year home Match times, only Match times during the above time frames will be allowed (unless both Captains agree to rescheduling an individual Match at a mutually agreeable time).**
- ONLY Teams playing out of clubs physically located in the Chicago District (Cook, Lake, and DuPage counties) will be accepted into the Adult League program.
- Team Applications will only be accepted from a maximum of 2 Teams sharing the same court time.
- The required minimum number of Players on a roster must be met by the start date of the Season as reflected on TennisLink. If any Team does not meet the requirement by the start of the Season, the Team will be removed from the League.
- The Chicago District and the Northern Illinois District collaborated to create ONE timed Match procedure for use in both districts. The new procedure can be found on both websites.
