



## 2023 USTA Midwest Tennis on Campus Section Championship

February 24-26, 2023

*Nielsen Tennis Stadium (University of Wisconsin-Madison)*

Matches will start at 8 a.m. Central time on Friday, February 24.

**Entry Fee:** \$275 per team to be paid via [USTA Midwest TOC Formstack Registration form](#).

**Entry Deadline:** **Friday, February 10, 2023, at 5 p.m. Eastern**

- The first 32 teams who **PAY the entry fee** via the Formstack link will be guaranteed a spot in the 32-team draw. The roster form can be submitted up until the deadline and does not have to be submitted with payment.
- Once entries reach 32 teams, a waitlist will be started for any additional teams who register and pay. Teams will be listed based on the order in which they registered (33, 34, 35, and so on). If you are on the waiting list and do not get into the event, you will receive a 100% refund of the entry fee.
- **"B" Teams should not register or pay at this time.** If you have a B team that is interested, please let the tournament directors know. If we do not reach 32 "unique schools" to fill the draw, we will reach out to any interested "B" teams to register.

**Team Roster Form:** Complete the [team roster form](#). The roster must be received by the **February 10** entry deadline. (You may change a player on the roster after the deadline if something comes up; Please contact Tyson to do so.)

**University Confirmation:** [THIS LINK](#) must be signed off by a staff member for the university/college within the club sports department. This can be the director or an assistant within the department that your club team works with.

**Player Consent and Waiver Form:** Complete the consent/waiver form and scan or email your form to Tyson Thompson at [Tyson.thompson@midwest.usta.com](mailto:Tyson.thompson@midwest.usta.com), or bring the signed document to the tournament desk on the day of your first match. The document must be signed by **ALL** participating team members.

**Player Registration USTA Platform:** Player registration on the USTA platform "**Serve Tennis**" must be completed by all individual players before your first match. Instructions on how to do this can be found via the attachment in the email. Please share this document with your players. USTA memberships are not required but everyone must have a "free" USTA account to complete the registration process.

**Host hotels:** Two hotels have been reserved with room blocks for the event. Teams are strongly encouraged to book their rooms now as rooms are VERY limited at each hotel due to a state wrestling tournament also taking place over the same weekend. **Amenities:** All players will receive a tournament gift and lunch cards on Friday/Saturday. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of four matches.

**Tournament Format:** World Team Tennis collegiate format will be used.

**Teams:** We suggest teams have at least three men and three women (**maximum 10 players**) available to play all weekend, but teams may play with only two players of each gender.

**Individual Eligibility:** Undergraduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of ½ full-time and graduate students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours. Players may not be a current varsity team member. There is a limit of one former varsity player per team. For more info, [click here](#).

**Rules:** USTA rules will be followed throughout the tournament where applicable. Any variations will be discussed during the Captain's Meeting.
