Team Entry Fee: \$300 per team to be paid via [USTA Midwest TOC Registration form](#).

Team Entry Deadline: February 5, 2025, at 6 p.m. Eastern

- The first 32 teams who **PAY** the entry fee via the registration form will be guaranteed a spot in the 32-team draw. Rosters can be submitted up until the set deadline and do not have to be submitted with payment.
- Once entries reach 32 teams, a waitlist will be started for any additional teams who register and pay. Teams will be listed based on the order in which they registered (33, 34, 35, and so on). If you are on the waitlist and get selected at any point, you will be sent the form to register/pay for your team with a 24-hour deadline.
- **"B" Teams should not register or pay at this time.** If you have a B team that is interested, please let the tournament directors know. If we do not reach 32 "unique schools" to fill the draw, we will reach out to any interested "B" teams to register.

Team Roster Form: Complete the [Team Roster Form](#). The roster must be received by **February 12, 2025**. (You may change a player on the roster after the deadline if something comes up; Please contact Tyson to do so.)

Team Roster Serve Tennis: Team Roster "MUST" be created within the Serve Tennis platform by **February 12, 2025**. Create your team roster on the USTA Team Management Platform and name your roster as: "Midwest Champs A"

Note, if you have not yet claimed your team in the system, please email Tyson Thompson with your USTA # to receive information on completing this step*

University Confirmation: The [Admin Verification Form](#) must be signed off by **February 12, 2025**, by a staff member for the university/college within the club sports department or other department if they are your club liaison.

Player Consent and Waiver Form: All players must check off the waiver when completing the individual player sign up on the main tournament website.

Event Start Time: Matches will start at 8 a.m. Central time on Friday, February 21, 2025. Special scheduling accommodation **will not** be considered due to the number of teams involved. Plan for your first match time to be between 8am and Noon.

Host hotels: Two hotels have been reserved with room blocks for the event. Teams are strongly encouraged to book their rooms now as rooms are VERY limited at each hotel. Amenities/Guarantees: All players will receive a tournament gift and lunch cards for Friday/Saturday. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of four matches. A small number of teams will finish on Saturday night (depending on results) while the remaining teams will wrap up on Sunday.

Tournament Format: ITT scoring and match formats will be used as in past years. Rules and scorecard will be sent prior to the event for review and any questions from new teams or players.

Teams: We suggest teams have at least three men and three women (**maximum 10 players**) available to play all weekend, but teams may play with only two players of each gender.

Rules: All USTA rules will be followed throughout the tournament where applicable.

Individual Eligibility: Undergraduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of ½ full-time and graduate students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours. Players may not be current varsity team members. **There is a limit of one former varsity player per team.** For more info, [click here](#).
