

USTA/Midwest Tournament Multiple Entry Process (as of January 1, 2022)

Action is Required

The following applies to USTA/Midwest Closed Level 3, Open & Closed Level 4, and Open Level 5 junior tournaments.

- I. Players signing up for multiple age divisions within the same Midwest Level event (example: Girls 16 Level 4 and Girls 14 Level 4):
 - a. Written permission is NOT required from the Tournament Director to sign up for multiple age divisions within the same Midwest Level event.
 - b. Players will be selected in descending order from older age division to younger age division 18, 16, 14, 12, and 10s. Once selected for the older age division, players will be removed from the younger age division event.
- II. Players that are signing up for different Midwest Level events (example: Boys 14 Level 4 and Boys 14 Level 5)
 - a. Written permission IS required from both Tournament Directors to sign up for two different Midwest Level events.
 - b. If player is selected for the higher-level event, the player must withdraw from the lower-level event. If a player fails to do so, the player will be withdrawn from the lower-level event and will receive four USTA Suspension Points for improper withdrawal and will receive no refunds.
- III. Players that are alternates:
 - a. Players may remain an alternate on more than one tournament list.
 - i. If you are contacted for a playing position that you accept, you must email the tournament director and copy the Midwest Office at jrtourney@midwest.usta.com to remove you from the other alternate list. If a player violates this policy, they will receive four USTA Suspension Points for improper withdrawal and will receive no refunds.
 - b. If players are on one or more tournament lists (alternate/alternate or alternate/competitor), this player may remain on both lists and will have until 5:00pm on Monday (five days before the event begins) to remain in one tournament. This player must email the tournament director and the Midwest Office at jrtourney@midwest.usta.com with the decision.
