

USTA/Midwest Tournament Multiple Entry Process (as of January 1, 2017)

Action is Required

USTA/Midwest Players may sign up for multiple age divisions within each Midwest Level 1 Midwest Level 2 or Midwest Level 3 tournaments WITHOUT requesting Tournament Director permission (*This Multiple Entry Process does not apply to the 2017 Midwest Closed Outdoor Championship. That tournament requires a different endorsement procedure*).

- I. Players signing up for multiple age divisions within the same Midwest Level event. (example Girls 16 Level 1, Girls 14 Level 1)
 - Players will be selected in descending order from older age division to younger age division 18, 16, 14, 12, and 10s. Once selected for the older age division, players will be removed from the younger age division event.

- II. Players that are Alternates.
 - You may remain an Alternate on more than one tournament list.
If you are contacted for a playing position that you accept you must email the Midwest Office immediately at jrtourney@midwest.usta.com to remove you from the remaining Alternate List. If a Player violates this policy they will receive five USTA/Midwest Suspension Points and will receive no refunds.
 - If Players are on one or more tournaments list (alternate/alternate or alternate/competitor), this player may remain on both lists and will have until **5:00pm Monday**, (five days before the event begins) to remain in one tournament. This player must email the USTA/Midwest office at jrtourney@midwest.usta.com with the decision.
