<b>District</b>	<b>Wildcard Process</b>
Central Indiana	Next players with highest 100% reliable UTR and no current code violations.
Chicago	Next highest finishers of District Championship
Mid-South Illinois	Next highest finishers of District Championship
Northeast Michigan	1. Winner of District Championship 2. Next player via National Standing List
Northeast Ohio	Next players via National Standing List
Northern Illinois	Next players via National Standing List
Northern Indiana	Next highest finishers of District Championship
Northern Michigan	Next highest finishers of District Championship
Northwest Ohio	1. Next highest finisher in the District Championship 2. Highest ranked player from the district after the District Championship (must have played in the District Championship or granted exemption) *This position can be given by vote of committee to an outstanding player who had been significantly sidelined for a prolonged period by illness or injury.
Ohio Valley	To be eligible, a player must: 1. Compete in the District Championships 2. Must compete in all matches unless an injury or COVID positive test/quarantine forces withdrawal District Process: 1. Winner and finalist of District Championship 2. Next player via National Standing List
Southeast Michigan	Next highest finishers of District Championship
Western Michigan	Next highest finishers of District Championship *The district reserves the right to change selection process in extremely rare circumstances where injury has held a very high player back from tournament play until the Midwest Closed.
Wisconsin	Next players via National Standing List
