

## **Match etiquette and courtesy on the court:**

- Captains print out a scorecard and bring it to the match; see that all scores are recorded and verified with players; sign the scorecard. You keep one copy and the opponent keeps a copy. Keep the original scorecard until scores are recorded on TennisLink and verified for accuracy.
- Sign in at the desk and pay your court fee before you head out for warm-up. Cost is \$15. Lifetime does not accept credit cards; cash, check, on your Lifetime account if a member.
- Warm-up courts before your match time are not provided by USTA, if you reserve a warm-up court at a facility you are expected to pay for the court.
- After your match leave the court – please don't stand around talking as it disrupts play on other courts or another match may be ready to start.
- Report your scores immediately – while players still remember the scores and before players begin to leave the facility.
- Be respectful of your opponents, spectators, staff... Show and use good sportsmanship.
