Adult Play Committee Rule Amendments

Sections 3 - Rosters, Section 11 - Match Procedures, have been revised to provide clearer guidelines.

ROSTERS:

Out-of-District Player Requirement

All teams competing within the USTA Kansas District must maintain a minimum of 30% in-district players on their roster to be eligible for advancement beyond local league play. Players are considered in-district based on their primary residence.

In addition, all team captains must reside within the Kansas District. Teams failing to meet this requirement will not be eligible for advancement under any circumstance.

Divisions that are unable to meet the 30% in-district player requirement may request a waiver; however, waivers will only be granted in limited and specific circumstances at the sole discretion of the District League Coordinator. Approval is not guaranteed.

MATCH PROCEDURE:

All timed matches must end promptly at the scheduled completion time. If a match cannot be fully completed due to time restrictions, play will cease immediately. The team that is ahead at the time play is stopped will be declared the winner.

Captains are responsible for ensuring the match is entered correctly in TennisLink and must select "Timed Match" in the dropdown when recording the score.
