

2025 New Hampshire One Doubles “Tri-Level” League Information

A traditional Tri-Level USTA League uses a format designed to provide a unique team experience by combining players of different NTRP levels on the same team. Considering the limited population of players in New Hampshire, the traditional Tri-Level League is run as a One Doubles League, meaning that each NTRP level is run as its own league instead of combining levels to create one team.

The League will be offered to both men and women at the 3.0, 3.5, 4.0 and 4.5 levels. In the event of multiple flights at any level, the flight winners will participate in a playoff. The winners of each level will be eligible to participate in the New England Sectional Tri-Level Championships. The winners of each of Men’s and Women’s Tri-Level Sectionals at the 3.5/4.0/4.5 NTRP levels will form one team to advance to the Tri-Level National Invitational Championship.

Guidelines

- To be eligible, a player must have a USTA membership valid through the end of the local season
- Minimum age is 18 years old within the current calendar year.
- Tri-level is NTRP based — In-Level Play is required. Only C Rated players may advance to Sectional Championships
- Tri-level is a straight level league (i.e. 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5)
- No defaults are allowed and all scheduled matches must be completed.
- Each player must be registered on their team roster on Tennislink before playing a match, and match results are reported on TennisLink.

General Overview

- A team match consists of 1 individual doubles match.
- A team consists of between 3-6 players.
- Format used: 2 out of 3 sets with 3 rd set being a 10-point tiebreak. Timed Match Play
- Players must play at their NTRP level
- Match results will be used in year-end NTRP ratings calculations.
- Players must play in a minimum of two matches to advance to Playoff and Sectional events (1 default will count).
- Matches will be scheduled by the League Coordinator: Women’s Match Play will be scheduled Tuesdays and Men’s Match Play will be scheduled on Saturdays. Match play may be scheduled indoors or outdoors. All Match Play Regulations may be found in the [New Hampshire USTA Local League Rules and Regulations](#).
- Sectionals will be held on the date to be determined in January in Western Massachusetts.
- For teams advancing to the Sectional Championship, a maximum of four players per level will be allowed to participate.
