Adult 18 Daytime Information:

Daytime Adult 18 & Over - 2.5+, 3.5 & 4.0

Evening and weekend tennis matches don't work well for you? Daytime 2.5+, 3.5 & 4.0 give you the opportunity to experience Adult Leagues while leaving the day and weekends open.

- 2.5's must play in the #2 doubles position
- Team matches start between 9am and 11am, Monday through Friday
- A 10pt match tie-break is used in lieu of all 3rd sets
- Daytime tennis will be considered a league of its own, running with the current league offering
- Daytime format will remain 1 singles and 2 doubles
- Flight winners will be determined after playoffs
- Flight winners will then advance to post season championship
- There is a \$90 registration fee per team to participate in the Sectional Championships for Daytime Adult 18 & Over league
- Players may advance in both daytime and traditional post season play – you no longer need to choose

League Information:

“At Level” Player Requirement: Adult 18 & Over teams must have a minimum of 6 players for five-line leagues or 4 players for three-line leagues who are rostered at the team’s NTRP level by the time the first match is played. Teams are required to maintain the required number of “at level” players throughout the entire season, including post season play. If a team does not have the required number of “at level” players at the time of any match, the team match will count as a loss with all individual team matches being scored as 6-0, 6-0 losses.

Ratings: Match data from this league will be used toward Year-End rating calculations.

Age Requirements: Players must be 18 years of age prior to participating in the USTA League program.

NorCal Adult 18 & Over Women’s 2.5+, 3.5 and 4.0 Daytime will play Monday through Friday, with matches scheduled to start between 9am and 11am. For 2.5+ Daytime, a team may have 3.0 players, they must play #1 singles and/or #1 doubles. (Maximum of three players 3.0 players per match.)

NorCal Adult 18 & Over 5.0+ will not be offered for the 2021 season.
