## 1. Chair Report

- Don stated that practice has started and is every Saturday. One student at SJSU is interested in wheelchair tennis and reached out via email.
- Marty asked how players are notified of practices. Group text? They use a group text on Whatsapp. Marty's group is listed as a free event on the USTA website. Encourage all players to register.
- Kylie gave the update on the All-Comers Camp. 6 Players registered for the All-Comers camp. All NorCal players will be reimbursed 50% of the fee for the camp. Caitlyn from Abilities 360 is a possibility to come to the camp.
- Adaptive Athletics Association update: Lots of rain in the Sacramento area. 2 young wheelchair tennis players are interested in coming out to learn tennis. Marty was approved by CSUS to run a wheelchair practice for their tennis club. Both wheelchair and able-bodied tennis players are playing. Bass is getting very good as a wheelchair tennis player. They are bringing the wheelchairs from the WELL to the tennis courts to drop off with Bass and then picking them up at 6pm after practice is over. This helps with players not having to cart their chairs across the school grounds. Possibly 3 wheelchair tennis players total could be a part of the tennis club team. Chris Comwate could possibly join.
