Arthur Ashe Kids Day- Volunteer Application

Arthur Ashe Kids' Day (AAKD) powered by USTA Net Generation® is an annual children's tennis event that will take place on Saturday, August 23rd, 2025. AAKD honors Arthur Ashe's legacy of instilling the values of humanitarianism, leadership and academic excellence and helps promote the sport of tennis to young people. AAKD features a host of interactive games, activities, pro player interaction, live music and entertainment throughout the grounds of the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center. AAKD is the largest single-day grass-roots tennis and entertainment event in the world (with more than 50,000 guests), allowing young people of all ages and ability levels to discover the many benefits that go hand-in-hand with an involvement in tennis.

Volunteers will have the opportunity to choose whether they would like to assist with on-court delivery efforts or off-court activities. Volunteers must be 16 or older by August 22nd, 2025. It takes incredible collaboration, numerous staff, as well as hundreds of volunteers, to make this day successful and memorable for so many kids and families, and we appreciate your help in sharing this opportunity with others within your section who may be interested in being part of the day.

2025 Net Generation US Open On Court Experience (Kids on Court)

This opportunity is open for facilities/programs and their athletes to play tennis on the courts of the US Open before matches begin. During this Net Generation experience, 24 players (ages 8-15) will have the opportunity to play on the courts of the US Open before matches begin. Groups arrive at the grounds before gates open the morning of their experience. They will receive a t-shirt and be let into the US Open grounds before the general public. All 24 kids, plus 1 guardian/parent each, will receive a grounds pass wristband for the day, allowing them to watch all matches except in Arthur Ashe Stadium. The group will have approximately 10 - 15 minutes on court to rally with their teammates and experience playing on the US Open courts.

Coaches and athletes will have the opportunity to share with fans the impact of red ball within their program as well as information about their organization as a whole. After the on court play experience is over, one youth athlete from the group MAY have the opportunity to stay on court and perform the coin toss for the upcoming match.

Please note, all expenses (travel, meals, etc.) are the responsibility of the program/facility to cover besides a t-shirt for the child, and a US Open grounds pass for the child and one guardian. There is potential for financial assistance for NJTLs travel through the USTA Foundation. Once groups are selected, this can be further discussed.
