



FAQ's for Adult Tournaments and NTRP Ratings

Q: Do NTRP Tournament matches count toward my NTRP Rating?

A: Yes. Beginning with the 2018 Rating Year, all USTA Sanctioned NTRP Tournaments within the Pacific NW will count towards your Year End Rating

Q: Do Age Division and Open Tournaments count toward my NTRP Rating.

A: No.

Q: Do non-sanction NTRP Tournaments count toward my NTRP rating?

A: No.

Q: Why is USTA PNW now allowing for USTA Sanctioned NTRP Tournaments to count towards NTRP Ratings?

A: This will help players qualify for the NTRP National Championships as they do not allow self rated players. This should also help most tournament and league players achieve a more accurate rating as more data will be in the system with tournament matches.

Q: Do all USTA Sections count NTRP Tournaments in the Year End Ratings?

A: No. Sections can choose whether or not to count NTRP Tournaments in the Year End Ratings.

Q: Can I be Dynamically DQ'd (i.e. 3 strikes) from NTRP Tournament matches.

A: No. USTA Sanctioned NTRP Tournament matches do not generate strikes and, therefore, you cannot be Dynamically DQ'd from tournament matches.
