RE: Schedule Details for 2021 Adult 18 & Over
League

The USTA/PNW has set some guidelines that we will enforce for the 2021 Adult 18 & Over USTA League season. Below are further details:

- Spokane League Boundaries for Adult 18: Medical Lake, Cheney, Airway Heights, Nine Mile Falls, Colbert/Green Bluff, Rathdrum ID, Hayden, Couer d'Alene, Liberty Lake, Valleyford
- If there are less than four teams in both areas (Spokane and Central Washington) for the 4.5 and 5.0 levels only, then both areas will combine to only play one weekend. See below for which weekends will be used in this scenario:
 - Men – April 16-18 (Tri-Cities) ○ Women – April 16-18 (Tri-Cities)
- If either area (Spokane or Central Washington) has four or more teams for the 4.5 and 5.0+ levels only, then each area will need to play their own local league and the top two teams from each local league will advance to the Eastern Area League Championships to be played on April 16-18 in Tri-Cities.
- For the 4.0, 3.5, 3.0 and 2.5 divisions, If there is only one team in Spokane with multiple teams in Central Washington, then the single Spokane team MUST play all matches on the Central Washington weekend date as listed below.
 - Adult 18 Women - January 29-31 (Tri-Cities)
 - Adult 18 Men – February 26-28 (Tri-Cities)
