# USTA League Scheduling Guidelines for One-Weekend Events - Southern Oregon

Below is the scheduling format that will be used for all Southern Oregon One-Weekend leagues. This will be used when there are enough courts to accommodate this. If there are not enough courts, the Regional League Coordinator or Director of Competition may modify the number of Round Robins listed below.

**2 Teams** – Triple RR (3 matches per Team)

**3 Teams** – Double RR (4 matches per team)

**4 Teams** – Double RR (6 matches per team)

**5 Teams** – One RR (4 matches per team)

**6 Teams** – One RR (5 matches per team)

**7 Teams** – 2 Flights Flight A – 4 Teams – RR (3 matches per team) Flight B – 3 Teams – Double RR (4 matches per team) Semi Final – A1 vs B2 Semi Final – A2 v B1 Final

**8 Teams** – Remain in one Flight but randomly play four teams. The top four teams will advance to Local Area Playoffs: #1 vs #4 and #2 vs #3; then a Final with the winners of the semi-finals.

Alternatively: 2 Flights Flight A – 4 Teams – RR (3 matches per team) Flight B – 4 Teams – RR (3 matches per team) Semi Final – A1 vs B2 Semi Final – A2 v B1 Final

**9 Teams** – Remain in one Flight but randomly play four teams. The top four teams will advance to Local Area Playoffs: #1 vs #4 and #2 vs #3; then a Final with the winners of the semi-finals.

(This has been done at National Championships since 2018.)

Alternatively: 2 Flights Flight A – 5 Teams – RR (4 matches per team) Flight B – 4 Teams – RR (3 matches per team) Semi Final – A1 vs B2 Semi Final – A2 v B1 Final 10 Teams – 2 Flight

**10 Teams** – 2 Flights Flight A – 5 Teams – RR (4 matches per team) Flight B – 4 Teams – RR (3 matches per team) Semi Final – A1 vs B2 Semi Final – A2 v B1 Final 10 Teams – 2 Flight

Alternatively: Remain in one Flight but randomly play four teams. The top four teams will advance to Local Area Playoffs: #1 vs #4 and #2 vs #3; then a Final with the winners of the semi-finals.
