

Do you need to take the Roving Umpire Knowledge Check?

1. Log into [OfficialsFirst](#)
2. Go to your "My Certification" page
3. Look at the "Core Requirements" section and find the "USTA Certified Official Requirement"

If this says "Complete" - You are good to go!! You do not need to complete the Roving Umpire Knowledge Check!

If this says "Incomplete" (as shown above), consider the following:

- A. Were you certified, for the first time, *after* April 1, 2024?
 - a. If so, you don't need to complete the knowledge check.
- B. Did you work two full days as a Roving Umpire since November 1, 2023?
 - a. If so, check that you entered your work records correctly.
 - b. Once your work records are accurate in OfficialsFirst, the requirement will change to "Complete."
- C. Will you work 2 full days as a Roving Umpire before October 31, 2024?
 - a. If so, you won't need to complete the knowledge check.
 - b. After you have completed your work assignment, enter your work records in Officials First as soon as possible. Once your work records are accurate in OfficialsFirst, the requirement will change to "Complete."
- D. If the answer to all of the above is "No":

You *will* need to complete the Roving Umpire Knowledge Check!

Remember:

The Roving Umpire Knowledge Check is ONLY required if you were first certified before **April 1, 2024**, and you will not enter 2 full days serving as a Roving Umpire at a qualifying event before **October 31, 2024**. See Table 1 of the [USTA Officiating: Certification Regulations](#).
