



## Central Indiana Tennis Association Regulations for Local Leagues

The following details the organization mandates for the operation of USTA Adult League Tennis for participating clubs and associations.

The USTA

**1.3 NON-DISCRIMINATION.** Discrimination in USTA League is prohibited as specified in the Bylaws of the United States Tennis Association.

**1.4 B(3) Section Associations.** The USTA has 17 Section Associations; the names and territories of which are defined in the USTA Bylaws. Each Section Association is responsible for the development and implementation of the USTA League within its geographic territory in accordance with the USTA LEAGUE REGULATIONS.

**1.04B(4)b Local League Coordinators.** Each Section League Coordinator may appoint Local League Coordinators to implement and administer the USTA League. The Section League Coordinator must approve all such appointments.

It is recommended that the CITA make specific additions to the following regulations for USTA Local Leagues playing inside the CITA District.

Each local league will be administered by a local league coordinator who is under the direction of the Central Indiana Tennis Association District League Coordinator.

The definition of specific geographic areas (counties) for each local league will be defined by the CITA. Players (teams) may choose home match locations within these geographic areas for all local league matches. Teams will be offered 50% of their matches to be played at their home location, **when possible**, by the Local League Coordinator. Players (teams) outside of these geographic areas must play home matches at designated sites inside the geographic area (counties) designated for the local league.

A guideline for a specific percentage of participants by county has not been established. Currently any population of players per county of 25% or greater was used to determine the county boundaries for each local league.
