NATIONWIDE STRUCTURE OF TOURNAMENTS
NATIONWIDE POINTS-PER-ROUND RANKING SYSTEM
STANDINGS LIST



Starting January 2021, the USTA is adopting a simplified nationwide structure, which will create a standardized system and greater consistency for our players, parents, coaches, tournament directors and officials. Read the information below for the USTA Junior Tournaments (Ranking) Breakdown by Level for Players in USTA/Midwest Section.

CHANGES FOR 2021

- » Selection for all quota events will take your national ranking first and then quota second.
- » The Section quota selection list for 14s, 16s and 18s will take your best six events, but only three of them may be from an event not sanctioned in your Section.
- » The Section quota list for 12s will take your best six events, but only two of them may be from an event not sanctioned in your Section.



NATIONAL

LEVEL 2 (4+ DAYS)

- » Will stay the same as they currently are in 2020.
- » Sections may sanction one cross sectional team event.

LEVEL 3 (4+ DAYS)

- » National will continue to sanction level 3s, except they will no longer take place in January and July.
- » Each Section will sanction two Section Level 3 closed events: Summer Closed (June) | Winter Closed (January)



SECTION

2021 LEVEL 4 (UP TO 4 DAYS) = 2020 SECTION LEVEL 2

- » Each Section will sanction four Closed Level 4s and four Open Level 4s. You can play in any Section's Open Level 4 event.
- » Each Section will sanction one Closed Level 4 team event (Team Cup).

2021 LEVEL 5 (UP TO 3 DAYS) = 2020 MIDWEST LEVEL 3

- » Each Section will get an allotment of Open Level 5 tournaments to sanction.
- » The Midwest will also have up to two Closed District Level 5s to sanction as needed.



DISTRICT

2021 LEVEL 6 (UP TO 2 DAYS) = 2020 DISTRICT LEVEL 4

- » Each District will sanction Level 6s as necessary with no limit.
- » Players will receive points per win with a maximum of four wins per tournament.

2021 LEVEL 7 (1 DAY) = 2020 LEVEL 5 SINGLE DAY SHOWDOWN

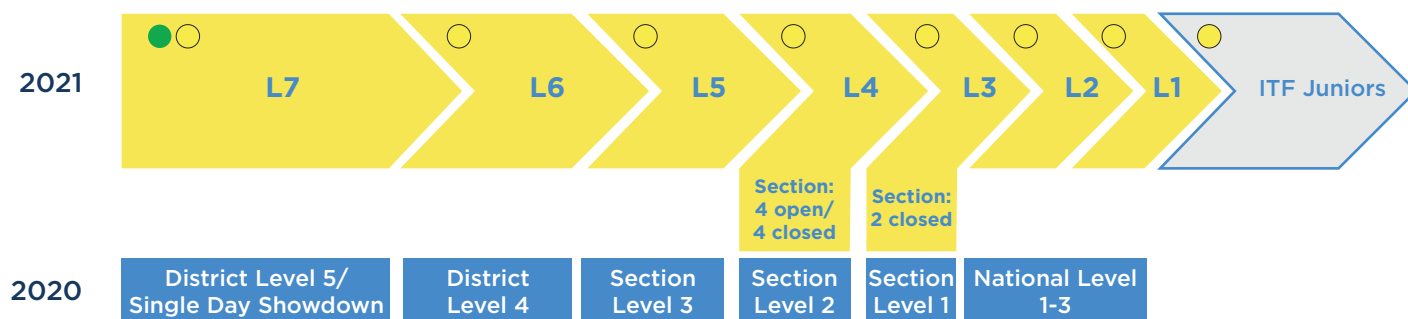
- » Each District will sanction level 7s as necessary with no limit.
- » Players will receive points per win with a maximum of four wins per tournament.
- » All players must be USTA Members to participate.

- » Everyone in the country is on one ranking list.
- » Singles and Doubles results are combined into one ranking.
- » 15% of your best six doubles results will be added to your singles points.
- » 20% of your results in the current age division will automatically count up into the next age division.
- » Quota lists will be run periodically that will be used for selection into National Championship events. Those lists will be run using only three tournaments played outside of your home Section for the 14-18 age divisions. For the 12s, you will be able to count two tournaments outside your home Section.
 - There will be a standings list and a quota list that will be run differently.
- » Point tables have been created for each draw type that will be used to create all standings list.
