

Combo League High Level Rules and Guidelines:

1. Play is governed by the RULES OF TENNIS, “The Code” as contained in the 2021 Friend at Court, and the following Combo Doubles New England Section Regulations.
2. USTA New England will adhere to the USTA League National and/or New England and/or local Regulations on items not mentioned in the USTA New England Combo Doubles Regulations.
3. A team shall consist of three positions (local league can decide to have two positions).
4. Standard rating rules and regulations apply with the following differences. Players will use their current rating to register. Combo will not generate dynamic ratings nor be used for yearend ratings.
5. Three Strike Disqualification as part of an Adult League Program that generates dynamic ratings will require the player to move up and use their new rating in the Combo League.
6. A team shall consist of a minimum of 3 eligible doubles positions (2 if the local league is only playing two positions). An eligible doubles position is one that complies with the combined rating requirement.
7. The format of play will be three individual men’s or women’s doubles positions per team match (As noted in (3.) above, a local league may decide to offer a format of two individual men’s or women’s doubles positions per team match).

Each individual doubles team's combined NTRP ratings may not exceed the level entered. Individual doubles team's may not be more than .5 apart.

10. Age groups: 18 & Over; 40 & Over; 55 & Over.
