While we were all watching a tennis match, Billy Jean had the weight of every woman in America on her back. As a tennis player and as an American, this was a proud moment for me.

In the end, Billy Jean gave credit to her tennis in the parks upbringing and the important role that public tennis courts played in her life. Today, we are working to continue that important initiative across the United States. It is more important than ever to look for public court funding opportunities in your area and to be advocates for these dollars. Who knows, with the right opportunity, we might just be able to provide the training ground for the next Billy Jean King.

Gene Scott, Editor, *Tennis Week*

Although Gene was best known on the East Coast of our country, his influence has directly affected Texas tennis along with the rest of the country. He was well respected by the top players of his era from Texas such as Ron Fisher, Sam Giammalva, Paul Christian, Tim Heckler, Jim Parker, and others.

Gene first found notoriety as a player. He was ranked in the top ten USLTA Men's Singles for five years with his highest ranking of #4 in 1963. He played Davis Cup for the US twice and never lost in four matches. His continued passion for competitive tennis kept him ranked nationally in USTA age divisions up through the present time. I first met Gene Scott at a National 35 and over Men's event played at the Houston Racquet Club in 1983. I was playing in the Men's 35's while Gene was in the 45's. He was always a favorite.

However, Mr. Scott's true contributions to tennis came from his outspoken approach to cure the ailments of what he saw as a bureaucratic sport. He found the perfect forum as editor of the very popular *Tennis Week* magazine. He questioned everything from the USTA's spending habits to the absurd schedules of the Men's and Women's professional tours. His last editorial was typical as he supported the Davis Cup (implied Fed Cup) as the real meaningful tennis fulfillment. He spoke of Andy Roddick's finishing his recent match in Davis Cup through his sickness because he was playing for his country and not just himself. In short, he forced the tennis industry into introspection. Placed on the USTA Board of Officers a few years ago, he definitely influenced, and supported, a new direction for tennis in the big picture. Supported by many others, the big gorilla of tennis blended its resources throughout the entire tennis jungle.

Although some of us did not always agree with Gene Scott's comments, we all rushed to open the magazine to his editorial to find out what he had to say. We will miss that moment.





Texas is one of the few states to have both a tennis hall of fame and a tennis museum. The museum is located in a 15,000 square foot Texas Sports Hall of Fame complex in Waco.



## paul christian


Paul Christian was the Texas Boys Doubles Champion, playing for Wichita Falls High School in 1959. He was Captain and #1 player for the TCU Men's team (1959-63). He won the Men's Singles and Doubles Texas Open titles in 1971 and has won 17 Texas titles since 1968. He was ranked #2 in the USTA, winning the National Grass Courts Men's 45 Doubles. As a coach Paul Christian's team from CC Miller won the AAAA state championship. He directed the Texas Junior Davis Cup Camp, and was coach at the University of Houston (1968-74), when they won the Southwest Conference Championship and had five top-ten NCAA players. Christian served on the USPTA Texas Division board from 1991-1999 and was president of the USPTA Texas Division 1997-8. He also serves on the Houston Tennis Association Board, Club Corporation National Tennis Committee and the USPTA Testing Committee. He was tournament director for the 1971 Virginia Slims, Glen Campbell and Lloyd Bridges Pro-Celebrity, and Chuck Norris' Charity Tournament tournaments.



## tim heckler

Tim Heckler was a top junior tennis player in South Africa before coming to play for Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas. His team remained unbeaten for his four years with wins over top NCAA teams. He played Wimbledon and the US Open and was ranked as high as 53 in the world (1973). Tim Heckler ran the Houston Open, now known as the Houston Coca-Cola Open Tennis Tournament for the Houston Tennis Association and was Consultant/Director for the famous Bobby Riggs vs. Billie Jean King "Battle of the Sexes" match in the Houston Astrodome, September 1973, a precursor to the tennis boom of the 1970s and 80s. He has served as a member and president of the USPTA Texas Division Board (1974-75), the USPTA Executive Committee, the USPTA national Board of

Directors and a number of USPTA and USTA committees. He developed and promoted "Little Tennis", a program introducing children (ages 3-10) and their families to tennis - tennis answer to baseball's Little League. Tim Heckler has contributed to tennis in education for teaching professionals through his work with the USPTA and has worked to build and maintain strong and cooperative relations between the USPTA, its teaching professionals and the USTA.



## bill owen

Dr. William Owen played in his first tournament in 1939, winning the Henderson County Boys Singles Championship. He played on the Highland Park High School team where he won the UIL Regional Championship. Dr. Owen has been ranked annually 26 of the past 30 years in the Texas Section, winning the Sectional doubles 6 times in various age divisions. He won the Texas Sectional Father/Daughter Doubles in 1976 and advanced to the US Championship at Forest Hills, losing in the semis. He represented Texas in USTA Intersectional Championships in 1995 and 1997. Dr. Owen has volunteered with the Texas Tennis Association/USTA Texas Section for the past twenty-two years. He has served on the Texas Tennis Association Management Committee thirteen years, as president of the Texas Tennis Association (1989-90), President of the Houston Tennis Association (1985), delegate to the USTA and its Executive committee, chairman of the USTA Presidents Committee and has served on numerous USTA committees for the past eighteen years. Dr. Owen started the first USTA League program in Houston as President of the Houston Tennis Association, and the first 50s doubles league and first 65s doubles league.

Jim Robinson of Belton (Umpire of the Year), Todd Taylor of College Station (Lloyd Sessions Educational Merit Award), Sam Hopkins of Jacksonville (USTA Texas Section Community Service Award), Liz Storie posthumously of Harker Heights (Julius Zinn Seniors' Service Award), Carol Welder of Austin (W.T. Caswell Service Award), The Austin Tennis Academy (USTA Texas Section Organization of the Year) and The Dr. Alfredo Trevino, Jr. Family of Laredo (USTA Texas Section Family of the Year) were all recognized for their contributions to tennis.

The USTA Texas Section Umpire of the Year Award, established in 1981, recognizes an USTA certified official for his/her outstanding service and time spent working to strengthen officiating in the Texas Section.

Inaugurated in 1989, the USTA Texas Section Community Service Award honors an individual who provides outstanding contributions in promoting and conducting recreational

tennis programs for adults and/or juniors.

The Lloyd Sessions Educational Merit Award, established in 1979, recognizes an individual that is actively involved with junior players. This individual must exhibit outstanding activities at a professional level in building stronger junior tennis players at all levels of play.

First awarded in 1962, the W. T. Caswell Service Award is given to the Texas resident who has made valuable contributions to the growth and development of tennis in Texas, working as a volunteer within the framework of the USTA (United States Tennis Association) Texas Section.

Since 1975 the USTA Texas Section has honored a family for their contributions to Texas tennis as The USTA Texas Section Family of the Year.

The Julius Zinn Seniors' Service Award was first awarded in 1997 and honors a senior member of the USTA Texas Section who has made a contribution through his/her efforts, willingness, cooperation, and participation. This individual is most deserving of the respect and honor of the seniors, either in play and/or organizational work for the betterment and furtherance of senior activities.



### Texas Foundation undergoes name change to the Texas Tennis and Education Foundation



TEXAS TENNIS AND EDUCATION FOUNDATION

The USTA Texas Section's charitable 501(c)(3) organization has recently undergone a name change. **The Texas Tennis and Education Foundation**, as it is known today, is charged with the task of promoting health and education

through tennis in Texas. The foundation is devoted to assisting developing players in Texas tennis and has established funds dedicated for underprivileged players, special populations, college scholarships, competitive player travel assistance, and the Texas Tennis Museum and Hall of Fame. Through its assistance, the dreams of our youth and goals of our tennis players will be realized.

Since the inception of the foundation, the educational scholarship program which provides graduating high school seniors and undergraduate college students with the needed funds necessary to gain further education. For many of the awardees, college education would not be a possibility due to their financial situation. The foundation has awarded over 100 scholarships in the past 35 years.

The foundation considers itself a steward of money donated by its benefactors. Recently, the **Texas Tennis and Education Foundation** provided donated funds for the purchase of 3 wheelchairs to be used by the **USTA Texas Section's Wheelchair Tennis program**. Initially the wheelchairs will be used by Tennis Service Representatives (TSRs) throughout Texas to create awareness that the sport of tennis is available to potential players with disabilities. As additional funds become available, these and additional wheelchairs will become more readily available to more and more communities and eventually gifted to specific players of need.

The **Texas Tennis and Education Foundation's** Competitive Player Travel Assistance Grant has provided many of our best junior players in the state with the assistance necessary to compete in National and/or ITF scheduled events. In 2005, \$20,000 was awarded to 30 individuals and several of the players reached a #1 ranking in the US during the year.

Through the benevolent work of the **Texas Tennis and Education Foundation**, children in Texas will be assured of having the opportunity to further their athletics, education, and dreams of becoming leaders in our communities.

### texas players dominate the 30 hard court championships

The 2006 USTA National 30 Hard Court Championships, held March 11-16 at the Westwood Country Club in Austin, were once again dominated by Texas Section players this year.

In the 35 doubles Houstonians Margaret Kitchen and Philippa Palmer, seeded second, who were ousted by Hess and Schaefer in the quarterfinals, came in fourth. Lynn McWilliams, Lakeway, and Susan Whiting, Dallas, took fifth place over Works and Wright.

No. 3 Kathy Vick, Lubbock, reached the quarterfinals of the 45 singles, where she was upset by No. 5 Gerda Preissing, Germany, 4-6, 6-2, 7-5, then came in sixth in the consolation. McWilliams and Whiting, seeded fourth in the 45 doubles, reached the finals, where they fell to the No. 1 seeds, Preissing and Susan Wright, Grand

Junction, Colo., 6-1, 5-7, 6-4.

Vick and Shelly Stillman-Scott, Salinas, Calif., reached the semifinals of the 55 doubles. A play-off for third was not held. Carol St. Clair, Cypress, and Terri Thyssen, Spring came in fifth over Susan Bushman and Mary Morgan, both Houston, after reaching the quarterfi-

## BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

USTA Texas Section's very own Todd Carlson, Adult Recreational Programs Coordinator is the recipient of the first annual Tennis On-Campus Coordinator of the Year Award. The award was bestowed at the 2006 USTA Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida, in March on behalf of the USTA Collegiate Committee to honor and acknowledge a staff member who constantly seeks to increase participation throughout the campus community in innovative and exciting ways.

"Todd is absolutely one of the finest campus coordinators we have in the country. His passion for expanding collegiate recreational tennis in Texas is tremendous," explains Glenn Arrington, National Manager, Collegiate & Corporate Tennis, for the USTA national office, "I can not imagine a better candidate to receive our inaugural award."

Todd remembers what it is like to be in college and not have a tennis outlet. "I left the game after my four years of varsity tennis in high school and didn't come back until 10 years later," he says. "The one weekend intramural tournament at my college definitely didn't compensate for the lack of tennis."

Now Carlson is in a position to do something about that absence. Since he began focusing on the Tennis On Campus program one year ago, Carlson has expanded the Texas Campus

Championship from twelve teams in 2005 to 26 teams in 2006. And with the help from the Texas Collegiate Committee, he has worked on the formation of regional campus leagues. Today, Texas has six regional leagues with nearly 1,000 participating students on 32 teams, from 20 different college and university campuses.

These achievements have not gone unnoticed, and thus he is very deserving of this new award. "We've always had a very strong collegiate program, and Todd has only added to its success by and more than doubling the program in size. He has provided so many more playing opportunities for a segment of the population where we tend to see so much decline," adds Mike Carter, Director of Community Development for the Texas Section.

When asked why he has had such success Carlson simply explains, "I have a passion for these college students who don't have a tennis outlet, because I was one of them."



## NATIONAL CHAMPS

Defending National Champions, Texas A&M, captured the inaugural Texas Section On-Campus Championships in dramatic fashion over their rivals from the University of Texas, defeating the Longhorns, 22-21 (7-6), in a super tie-breaker on their home courts in College Station.

Elaine Wingfield from World Team Tennis traveled from Florida to serve as Tournament Director.

During the lunch break on Saturday where pizza was served, many of the players participated in the First Annual Wheelchair Mini-Net Championship. The event gave players a chance to try their skill at playing while in a competitive wheelchair in a three-point tie-breaker. There was also a prize court for candy.

UT Brownsville, which brought two teams from the Rio Grande Valley was recognized with the Spirit Award. The two teams included five siblings from the same family and one player who just started tennis two weeks ago. UT Brownsville made the trek traveling 388 miles one way.

West Texas A&M in Canyon was recognized for making the longest trip—a whopping 512 miles one way.



### BUTCHEE NAMED PTR MEMBER OF THE YEAR

The USTA Texas Section is proud to announce that one of its own, Kerlin Butchee, was named as the Texas State Member of the Year by the Professional Tennis Registry.

Butchee, who currently heads the USTA Schools, National Junior Tennis League and Multicultural Participation Programs for the Texas Section has been tireless in his efforts since joining the section.

"I am not surprised that Kerlin has received this honor from the PTR", said USTA Texas Section Executive Director. "His attention to tennis programs in Texas that will continue to grow the game has been exceptional and very productive. He has the knack and experience to make things happen."

Professional Tennis Registry (PTR) presented the State Member of the Year Awards to 27 of its members during the USTA Recognition Breakfast on Wednesday, February 22, at the Crowne Plaza Resort on Hilton Head Island, South Carolina. Each recipient has shown his or her dedication and diligence in promoting and supporting the great sport of tennis and PTR.

PTR is the largest global organization of tennis teaching professionals with more than 12,000 members in 123 countries. It has the greatest percentage of multicultural and women members of any such organization. PTR is dedicated to educating, certifying and servicing tennis teachers and coaches around the world in order to grow the game.

### HUBER, GROCE HONORED

Professional Tennis Registry also honored two other Texans, Tony Huber and Cari Groce. Huber received the PTR Humanitarian Award, while Groce received the PTR Coach Verdick Award for College Coach of the Year.

Immediately following Hurricane Katrina, Huber and his wife Liezel, the 2005 Wimbledon Doubles Champion, began helping displaced victims from New Orleans. The Hubers live in Houston, a hot bed for the newly homeless, with more than 100,000 evacuees descending on the city. Along with countless others, the Hubers wanted to help. Using Liezel's notoriety as a tennis champ, Tony and his wife created a web site - [www.LiezelsCause.com](http://www.LiezelsCause.com) to solicit funds and other necessities. The couple even opened their home to a family of 17 who ran out of gas trying to flee to Dallas. Liezel's Cause adopted no fewer than seven families, providing rent, utilities, furniture and whatever else they needed to get a fresh start in a new place. The disaster brought out the best and worst in people, and we are proud to know that Tony Huber and his wife were among the best.

Groce is in her third year at the helm of the Texas Tech Women's Tennis program, after 12 years as the Head Coach at Washington State University. While at WSU, she guided the Cougars to four NCAA Tournament appearances in five years and was named the Pac-10 Women's Coach of the Year and ITA Coach of the Year for the Northwest Region in 2001-02. She was also named Pac-10 Coach of the Year, North Division, in 1994, 1995 and 1996. On the academic side, her teams were awarded the Top WSU Athletic Award for overall highest GPA seven times, three first-team All Pac-10 Conference Academic selections, as well as eight Academic All-Americans and three Academic All-American teams. She also has served on the ITA Tournament Committee and was the National Chair of the men's and women's ITA Awards Committee in 2004. In July, 2005, Groce was named to the ITA Board of Directors. Recently, her Lady Raiders squad completed PTR on Campus Workshop. All of her team and assistant coaches are now PTR Certified.

## Texas Tennis Roundup in Houston a Great Success!

The Downtown Club at the Met in partnership with Special Olympics hosted the 1st Annual Texas Tennis Roundup. 61 athletes along with 25 coaches and parents registered for the event where local tennis professionals offered group instruction and skill development during the morning session, followed by supervised games and match-play in the afternoon.

The participants were divided into three groups according to tennis experience: Never Played, Have Played and Competitive. The beginners (over half of the group) were put into small groups and worked with pros and volunteers who used sponge balls and mini-nets to teach them groundstrokes, volleys, and serves. # TEXAS TRIO Awarded Starlit Honors in LA

Bert Cole of Dallas, Samuel Hopkins Jr. Ph.D. of Jacksonville, and Darrell Thompson of Waco affectionately known as the Texas Trio, claimed three separate national awards for the Texas Section at the 2006 USTA Community Tennis Development Awards banquet in February in Hollywood, CA. Both Hopkins and Thompson received recognition for their steadfast commitment to tennis as two of this year's Eve Kraft Community Service Award honorees. Cole, an equally service-oriented tennis enthusiast accepted an award for the National Junior Tennis League (NJTL) Chapter of the Year on behalf of the Dallas Tennis Association and their NJTL Program.

Through the Waco Tennis Association (WTA), Darrell Thompson runs tennis programming for 17 schools in Waco and the surrounding areas including the NJTL programs and many other junior development ventures. He has created numerous free after-school programs for youth that might not ordinarily be exposed to tennis. Thompson is also responsible for creating and hosting the first tennis coach's development workshop in Waco in more than 10 years, in which area schools received over 600 free racquets from the USTA. Thompson is also an integral member of many local tennis organizations including the USTA Texas Section Collegiate Committee, the USTA Texas Section Multicultural Committee, the Waco Tennis Association, and serves as a trustee for the Bernard and Audre Rapaport Tennis Foundation.

Within nine-months of moving to Jacksonville in 1977, Samuel Hopkins founded and organized the Jacksonville Tennis Association, and served as its first president. Over the next 28 years, he has been integral in growing the game throughout the area. Not only has the JTA grown to 400 members, but he has also created a strong infrastructure with qualified coaches, and many USTA sanctioned tournaments. He instituted a Jacksonville Tennis Hall of Fame for players and an annual Sportsmanship Award named for a beloved local tennis player Bob Bingham.

The National Junior Tennis League (NJTL) Dallas Chapter was started by the DTA in 1978. For over 25 years thousands of inner city and at-risk children have participated in this program. Each child is provided not only with free transportation to and from the nearest tennis center, but also with all of the equipment he or she need to play the game, from racquets and balls to apparel and shoes. Bert Cole and her dedicated staff have been instrumental in affording their NJTL Chapter this prestigious award two years in a row, both 2004 and 2005. A special thanks to Cole and her dedication to bringing kids of all shapes, sizes, and backgrounds into the game.

The USTA Texas Section is very proud of these award recipients and thanks them for service to the Texas tennis community. With the work of others like Cole, Hopkins, and Thompson many more lives will be touched and the game will continue to grow throughout.




Texas A&M University in College Station.

## CHAIRING TEXAS TENNIS



In a continuing effort to increase awareness and play occasions for wheelchair athletes, the USTA Texas Section's Wheelchair Committee took a proactive step in proposing budget money for six new sport chairs at USTA's Annual Meeting in February. The intended goal was for each Tennis Service Representative (TSR) to have a chair in their individual territories.

Since February, generous Texans have stepped up to donate wheelchairs in order to encourage this initiative. Dr. Alfredo Trevino and his wife donated the first chair to the section and soon after Ms. Gloria Dial and a group of her friends offered their funds for the purchase of two more chairs. The funds are being handled by Larry Eichenbaum, Executive Director of the Texas Tennis

Foundation. Because of their generosity, the Texas Tennis Foundation has begun talk about developing an on-going "Adopt-A-Chair" program. This is only the starting point for a very eager group of Texas tennis enthusiasts who will make a lasting impact through their acts of benevolence.

USTA Texas Section's President Lars Rosene reminds, "The purchase of these new chairs will help better support wheelchair tennis programs across Texas and will make our game more accessible to those with unique abilities."

Each chair purchased by individual donors or by the Texas Section will be used to expand wheelchair tennis exposure, to allow able body players to experience wheelchair tennis, to allow new wheelchair players to try tennis in a

sport chair, to increase integration opportunities, to allow TSRs to help tennis sites determine accessibility issues, to introduce junior able-bodied players to wheelchair tennis, to expand our diversity efforts, to allow existing wheelchair players to try new chair technology and maybe increase their frequency of play in doing so, to introduce wheelchair tennis to schools through assemblies, teacher trainings, etc, and to increase publicity of wheelchair tennis in Texas.

Already the section has used the new wheelchairs in able-bodied events, the first being the Tennis On-Campus Texas Sectionals held in College Station in early March. A three-point wheelchair mini-net tournament for college players was held during their lunch break. Over 50 players signed-up for the one-hour tournament. The players quickly gained respect and noticed the challenges of playing in a chair.

Ken McAllister, Executive Director, USTA Texas Section, reminds, "Many great tennis players have said that they got started when someone made a racket available to them. Now, sometime in the future, a wheelchair player will be able to say that he or she got started because of the availability of a chair by the Texas tennis community."

## TEXAS SECTION...YOU'VE BEEN CHAIRED

With the help of Blaze Sports the USTA Texas Section will begin a series of Up/Down Tournaments across the major cities of Texas. San Antonio, Houston, and Dallas will be the first to hold a portion of the series, with a state tournament held in Austin. Up/Down doubles teams consist of one able-bodied player and one wheelchair player. The USTA is dedicated to integrating wheelchair players and programs into able-bodied programs across the nation, and the Texas Section has taken a large step in the right direction by initiating the Up/Down Tournament Series.

The goal of the series is to have each city compete against each other in holding the best Up/Down tournament. For the first year or two every team will be invited to play in the state tournament, but once the tournament becomes too large, USTA and Blaze Sports will provide invitations to participate. The state tournament is destined to be an extremely fun and worthwhile trip, and will help Blaze and the USTA promote and recruit new players.

The USTA Texas Section is currently working to incorporate their national partnership at the local/sectional

level with Wendy Gumbert at Blaze Sports. Having learned that national partnerships come to fruition when local groups work together, the USTA has joined forces with the Dallas Tennis Wheelchair Association in hopes of revitalizing the sport.

Aiding in the success of these tournaments will be the purchase of fourteen sport chairs that will travel around the state to different tournaments, events, and programs introducing players, both able-bodied and wheelchair, to the new technology found in the latest sport chairs.

"In addition to the new wheelchairs, the up/down series sheds light on the fact that tennis is the first and only truly integrated sport where a wheelchair and an able-bodied player can compete on the same court," explains Mike Haynes, former #15 in the world and the Manager of St. David's Wheelchair Sports and Fitness Programs.

"We are excited about the potential of wheelchair tennis in Texas. With our dedicated volunteers, we are sure to exceed all expectations," shares Todd Carlson, Adult Programs Coordinator, USTA Texas Section.
