USTA TEXAS - 2013 YEAR IN REVIEW

With more than 54,000 members, Texas stands strong as the third-largest section in the United States Tennis Association. The Texas Legislature recognized the section with resolutions proclaiming April 16, 2013, as USTA Texas Day for the work and benefits of tennis to Texans.

The **Village Country Club** in Dallas was honored nationally as one of the nineteen 2013 USTA Facility Award winners. **Carol Welder** of Austin was named the USTA Barbara Williams Leadership Award winner for helping grow tennis at the local level, and **Cindy Benzon** of Houston was named the Professional Tennis Registry Texas Member of the Year. **Vonda Harris-Webb** of Grand Prairie, was named as one of the USTA National No-Cut Coach of the Year team members.



T Bar M in Dallas served as a USTA Certified Regional Training Center and hosted five Regional Player Development Camps.

There were over 68,500 junior tournament entries in 2013 with Texas juniors winning titles and finishing strong in tournaments across the country. **Grayson Broadus**, of Carrollton, teamed to win the 16s doubles title at the Winter Nationals along with **Danielle Quevedo**, from Tyler, winning the Girls 14s doubles. **Faris and Zane Khan**, of San Antonio, placed third in Boys 12s doubles while **Madison Hwang**, of Frisco, and **Chelsea Kung**, of Fort Worth, finished fourth in Girls 14s doubles.

Ellie Douglas, of McKinney, finished third in Girls 14s singles at the National Clay Court Championships along with **Peggy Porter**, of Dallas, placing third in Girls 18s singles. At the Hard Court Championships, Quevedo placed third in Girls 14s doubles and **Hada Chang**, of Trophy Club, teamed with Douglas to take third in the Girls 16 doubles. **Henry Gordon**, of New Braunfels, teamed to take third in the Boys 16s doubles.

Jr. Team Tennis supported 6,800 registered players with two Austin teams proudly representing Texas at the USTA Jr. Team Tennis National Championships. Both teams placed third in the 18 and Under Advanced division and in the 14 and Under Advanced.

Texas' statewide National Junior Tennis & Learning Kid's Days were led by Houston with 600 participants, followed by Dallas' 200 and Austin's 100. Duncanville native **Cody Stewart** was the national NJTL Arthur Ashe Essay Contest winner for ages 17-18.

Texas participation in adult tennis tournaments reached 19,977 entries reaping success statewide and nationally. Texas adult players collected 22 Gold Ball winners for first-place finishes in national events including five by **Margaret Canby**, of San Antonio, who won USTA women's 80 singles titles at the senior hard court, grass and clay championships along with partnering to win the doubles in indoor and clay.

Rachael Reed, of The Woodlands, won the women's open grass doubles crown, **Jorgelina Torti**, of Kingwood, captured the women's 35 singles title on clay. **Julie Cass**, of Austin, won the women's 40 singles and doubles title and **Vicki Buholz**, of Dallas, won the women's 50 singles title on grass, and both singles and doubles title indoors. **Kathy Langer**, of Rockwall, won the

women's 75 doubles.

Tony Dawson, of Horseshoe Bay, won the USTA men's 60 hard court singles and doubles title along with the clay doubles crown. **Mark Meyer**, of Flower Mound, won the men's 60 singles crown on clay. **Peter Markes**, of Austin, won the men's 55 singles title on grass while **Garry Nadelbaum**, of Kerrville, won the USTA men's 45 singles and doubles on grass and the indoor doubles. **Jason Holland**, of Portland, Texas teamed to win the mixed 30 doubles title.

Michele Haggerty and **Jackson Cobb**, of Austin, won the Mother/Son title at 2013 National Family Tennis Championships while **John** and **Tristan Stitt**, of Dallas, captured the Father / Son crown. **Charles Boyce**, of Cedar Hill, **Peggy Porter**, of Dallas, and the mixed doubles team of **John Mee** (Dallas) and **Karina Traxler** (Rockwall) represented the Texas section at the US Open National Playoffs. Texas won the USTA Women's 80 & Over Intersectional title and the Keith Donoff Men's Challenge Cup.





USTA Texas continued to boast a healthy league tennis program with 58,520 participants. Texas teams won USTA League National Championships with a Houston women's team winning the Adult 18 & Over 5.0 division and a men's team from Dallas taking the 40 & Over 3.5 division crown. Second-place finishes from a men's team from Dallas in the Adult 18 & Over 5.0 division and the Dallas mixed 18 & Over 8.0 doubles team solidly represented Texas.

Eight Texas schools competed among the nation's best at the USTA Tennis On Campus National Championships including **Baylor, Lone Star-CyFair, SMU, Texas A&M, Texas State, Texas Tech, UT-Austin** and **Texas at San Antonio**. The **Texas Christian University** men's team finished the season as the nation's collegiate attendance leader.

Professional team tennis moved to Texas. The **Texas Wild** from the Mylan World Team Tennis organization moved its Kansas City team to Irving. The team featured the world's No. 1 ranked doubles team **Bob and Mike Bryan** and reached the WTT playoffs. Success breeds competition in Texas when at the end-of-the-year, WTT announced that the Orange County (Calif.) team is moving to Texas as the **Austin Aces**, and will feature Texas native **Andy Roddick**.

The Wheelchair Run/Roll Series continued as one-day events with top players earning berths to the Invitational. The section introduced new adaptive tennis programs at Fort Hood Military Base in Killeen for the wounded warriors program, introduced tennis to the blind through-out

the Rio Grande Valley area in South Texas and supported three new delegations to attend the Special Olympics State games.

Cathy Beene, Bobby Kleinecke, Kathy

Langer and **Ken McAllister** were inducted into the Texas Tennis Museum and Hall of Fame and Team Texas defended its title at the annual USTA Section Shootout.

2013 Texas Tennis Hall Of Fame Inductees

Cathy Beene

Kingsville, Texas



Cathy Beene has played competitive tennis on all levels and has dedicated her efforts to the betterment of tennis through teaching and collegiate administration. A native of Kingsville, Texas, Beene was a member of the Junior Wightman Cup Team from 1967-1969 and was ranked No. 1 in Texas 18 and under in 1969.

At Lamar University, Beene won the USTA-AIAW National Tennis Doubles Championship in 1973 and was voted All-America. She turned professional in 1973 and went on to play the Avon Professional Circuit from 1977-78. She also coached the Texas Jr. Wightman Cup Team from 1974-79. Beene has taught at three different tennis clubs in Texas and has coached tennis at four universities: University of Texas at Austin, University of Houston, University of Texas at Arlington and at Georgia Southern University. She has coached five All-America athletes and was the Coach of the Year in the Southwest Conference in 1990 and the Southern Conference in 1998.

Beene has worked as an athletic administrator for over 20 years investing her time and efforts in the development of student athletes. Beene was the chair of the Men's and Women's NCAA Tennis Committee from 2011-12 as well as serving as a committee member on the Men's and Women's NCAA Committee. Beene is also a member of the Lamar University Athletic Hall of Honor (1993) and the Rio Grande Valley Hall of Fame (2012).

Bobby Kleinecke

Galveston, Texas



A native of Galveston, Texas, Bobby Kleinecke played tennis at O'Connell High School before winning five Missouri Valley Conference

singles and doubles titles at West Texas State. Kleinecke began coaching on the high school level at Corsicana, Amarillo and Bryan before beginning an illustrious career as the first ever head women's tennis coach at Texas A&M from 1985-2011.

He coached four All-Americans, 58 individual conference champions, 75 all conference singles and doubles citations and 22 NCAA individual qualifiers. Kleinecke had 417 career victories while leading his teams to 12 consecutive and 17 overall NCAA Women's Tennis Championship appearances. During his tenure, his teams finished the season ranked in the top 25 nine times and had 19 top three finishes in the Big 12 and SWC Conferences including three team titles.

Kleinecke won the 2002 Wilson / ITA Coach of the Year Award and was named SWC Coach of the Year in 1986 and Big 12 Coach of the Year in 2003

and in 2004 he was inducted into the West Texas A&M Hall of Champions in 2006. In 2008, he earned the USTA / ITA Community Outreach Award for the Southwest Region. Kleinecke has coached thousands of students through his summer tennis camps and created and directed numerous high school and ISTA tournaments.

Kathy Langer

Dallas



A native of Michigan, Kathy Langer did not play tennis until the age of 33 when

she began teaching the game to high school students. Langer developed a great love and talent for the game over the next 40 years. She has shared this passion for tennis with the citizens of North Texas since the early 1980s when she moved to Dallas.

Langer's natural talent and determination led her to play on USTA leagues with a 4.5 NTRP rating. She has been ranked No. 1 in singles in Texas for many years as well as ranked in the top five nationally in both singles and doubles. In 2005, she played at the ITF World Team Championships held in Turkey as a member of the Kitty Godfree Cup Team (65s) Her Queen's Cup (75s) Team won the cup in Croatia in 2012. In 2013, Kathy won the 75 doubles in the European Championships in Porschach, Austria which brought her a No. 1 Doubles (75) ITF World ranking.

Ken McAllister

Ken McAllister's impressive contributions to Texas tennis are numerous and varied. The San Angelo native began coaching high school tennis in Snyder (1964-1970) where his players won three UIL state titles. McAllister later coached at Deer Park High School (1970-1974) where he was an early advocate in the formation of UIL team tennis. A consummate teacher, he has taught over 30 state and nationally ranked players.

An accomplished player, he has had 35 Texas rankings since 1971, five USTA rankings since 1983 and won the 1988 PTR National 45 Singles Championship Among his many honors, he was named Texas Pro of the Year twice (1976 and 1980) and has been a USPTA Master Professional since 1987.

McAllister served as Director of Tennis at Walden on Lake Conroe, Montgomery, Lakeside Country Club and Lakeway World of Tennis. He has served as president of the Texas Tennis Coaches Association, the USPTA Texas Division and was inducted into the Texas Tennis Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

In 1991, McAllister became Executive Director for USTA Texas overseeing tennis programs in the Texas section of the USTA Under McAllister's leadership, the USTA Texas Section's staff and budget have grown as well as its membership – which now numbers approximately 54,000.





COMPETITIVE CORNER

Backhand Slice Still a Viable Play

The backhand slice is still alive and well. Among the greatest, if you want to Google them and check the technique, were Steffi Graf, Jose Luis Clerc, Martina Navratilova, and the undisputed God of all slices – Ken Rosewall.

This shot still has great relevance in today's game. (Thank you, Roger Federer!) It can be used on offense and defense; as a drive, an approach, a drop shot, or a lob. Tactically, it is very useful for countering a player who has difficulty with low balls. If we see a player with an extreme Western Forehand Grip, the first tactic in that match's game plan is "slice low to that forehand," and with great effect.

Some technical flaws that tend to come up often are:

- **Correct point of contact**
- **Keeping the racket face at the same angle throughout the swing**
- **And direction of the release and follow-through.**

First, the backhand slice needs to be struck well out in front of the leading hip. Late contact leads to two problems, incorrect impact with the ball (chopping down the back of the ball causing the ball to "float"), and distorting the finish because the late contact point forces a misaligned release.

The required early contact can be especially difficult for two-handed backhand players to adapt to, because the point of contact for the one-handed slice is much further out front.

The stable angle of the face as it moves through the ball is critical to create the action of "knifing through the ball." A changing face makes an inconsistent and unpredictable contact, resulting in turning the face under the ball, or "chili dipping" the shot – which pops up without penetration or direction.

The direction of the follow through is important as it not only helps direct the ball to the desired target, it increases the amount of time the ball is on the strings making more spin and control. Many players release the racquet across their body and to the outside due to over rotation, or a late pt of contact. Release the racquet towards your target and that will help. And keep it out front!

The old chip down the line and charge the net, daring the opponent to pass with their forehand IS dead.(at the top of the game) Modern racquets and strings help most solid players hit a dipping crosscourt pass off the forehand. However, many struggle to do the same on the backhand side, especially with the two hander. Hitting the backhand slice to that side is still a viable play, and even more so if you can move the opponent forward (and lower) or wide and low. We've all seen Federer hit that chip short and wide to the opponent's backhand side and pull them forward and off the court.

So get out and work on that backhand slice, and add it to your arsenal of weapons. And enjoy carving up your opponents!

USTA Texas' Role in Developing World-Class Players

Why are there no American men ranked in the Top 10 in the world and only one ranked in the Top 50? Many would suggest the root cause of this is fewer American children playing tennis. They are playing other sports – some such as lacrosse that were not a viable option 20 or 30 years ago. As a sport, we (tennis) have much more competition from other sports. Even worse, it may be that another “sport” – video games – results in fewer children playing sports or being physically active at all.

The mission of USTA Player Development is to develop world class American players through a clearly defined training structure and competitive pathway. So what is the role of USTA Texas and local Community Tennis Associations (CTAs) in accomplishing this mission? Not only do we have a regional training center and manage a year-long schedule of junior competitive tournaments, but the Section and CTAs are the primary providers of introductory tennis programs to children. Kids Clubs, after school programs, NJTL, and Junior Team Tennis are programs offered throughout the Section.

These programs are designed to help tennis “compete” with the other sports. Unlike volleyball, basketball, soccer and other sports, tennis is not a prominent sport in the physical education curriculum nor do we have a refined system community leagues and programs. This is where 10 and Under tennis comes into play. The Section has initiated a formal 10 and Under tennis program utilizing Red, Orange and Green balls to make tennis easier to grasp and thus more fun at a younger age and ability level.

This plan is producing a greater number of players that will continue to play in junior competitive programs. This play provides more young players the opportunity to excel and ultimately a greater pool of players for national player development. More and more kids playing tennis provide more potential for America to have another No.1 player in the world or a cadre of American players like we had with Sampras, Agassi, Courier and Chang or more recently, Blake, Fish and others.


