## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



### Why You Should Volunteer in Tennis Tom Hunt, USTA Texas President

*"True heroism is remarkably sober, very undramatic. It is not the urge to surpass all others at whatever cost, but the urge to serve others at whatever cost."*  
– Arthur Ashe

I have been amazed by this quote from one of America's greatest players. In his early years, he was taught to hit every ball that was within two inches of the line and to never argue with an umpire's decision. He was the first black man to win Wimbledon, the Australian Open and the US Open. He not only played professional tennis at an elite level, but more importantly, he spoke out against moral inequalities that existed both in and out of tennis. Based on his own words, on the court are off, the "urge to serve others at whatever cost" should provide the necessary motivation to volunteer.

The Texas section has over 50,000 members, 200 full-time volunteers and a staff of 28. Our mission is to grow the game, to encourage and embrace participation of all people who desire to be engaged with our organization. In addition, there are Community Tennis Associations throughout our section. These CTAs play a critical role in our success on how we deliver various programs for our children and adults. # WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FROM SOMEONE WHO RUNS IT

**T**eam Challenge and Team Tournament are two of the newest programs offered through Net Generation. To help you learn more about this first step before players move on to Junior Team Tennis, we tracked down a pilot provider, our very own Amanda Friday, to let us know what the programs are all about!

**USTA:** Why did you initially sign up for Team Challenge?

**AF:** Team Challenge came along at a time when Lubbock ISD elementary schools were eager for more with tennis, and we had an upcoming Pro Circuit event with the Team Luke Hope For Minds Tennis Classic at the Texas Tech McLeod Tennis Center, so a perfect avenue to showcase pro players, while getting the elementary kids out playing tennis against other schools. They had been doing fall units in their classes across the district, and it was fun for them to see friends from other schools who were doing the same thing. The PE teachers helped on court, and offered that familiarity to make it fun.

**USTA:** What was your first experience with Team Challenge like?

**AF:** Very enthusiastic controlled chaos! We had only six courts to work and anticipated 300 players. We divided each 78' court into six 36' courts, and had eight kids to a 36' court, rotating in and out and about, in two waves, eating pizza and watching pro matches. Needing volunteers is an understatement, it's a MUST! I think people don't ever want to commit to a big school district event because of the fear there won't be enough courts, but with 36' courts, it makes it easy for elementary, and even some middle school kids that were there, to have fun and interact with a lot of

different people. Use what you have and who you have to make it a great event.

**USTA:** What did the players and parents say?

**AF:** The players and parents all loved it! Some parents had never seen tennis before, or had any idea what to expect. So many questions came after of "Where can we play next?" "Are you doing this again?" "What facilities could we play at?" It leads to kids playing in the next JTT season as well because we had our Lubbock JTT coordinator there helping and answering questions, passing out info to players and parents. The parent education piece of Team Challenge came in key here because we had lots of small conversations that lead to their kids playing more.

**USTA:** Did you tie the Team Challenge to any community events or other tennis events?

**AF:** We tied it in with the Team Luke Hope For Minds Women's \$25K Pro Circuit event, which is held at Texas Tech. The kids loved getting to play on the Tech courts, but also seeing the pro matches was a win-win.

**USTA:** Where do you see Team Challenge going with the new Team Tournament?

**AF:** Team vs. Team is already a concept in high school, at some levels in middle school, and with Junior Team Tennis. I think we need to start it even earlier with this elementary age and really focus on that group because they're already used to their Little League, flag football, basketball and softball teams. We need to capitalize on that need and want of team camaraderie to help grow participation across all levels.

**Team Challenge** is an introduction to tennis competition offering a low-pressure team environment for children of all ages to develop their skills through level-based play, without an emphasis on instruction or results.

It is designed to be delivered as a single event or a series of up to six events, with the objective of providing a fun and social environment that highlights character and skill development. Team Challenge can be played with **red, orange or green tennis balls**.

## Ron Woods honored with George Bacso Lifetime Achievement Award

**R**on Woods of Corpus Christi, Texas received the George Bacso Lifetime Achievement Award at the USPTA General Membership Meeting on Friday, August 24 during the 2018 Tennis Teachers Conference at the Grand Hyatt New York in New York City. The George Bacso Lifetime Achievement Award is in honor of the late George Bacso, who served as the USPTA's Director of Certification and Academies along with being a national president from 1978 to 1980. This award honors individuals who dedicate a lifetime to raising the standards in volunteerism on behalf of tennis teachers and recognizes members who provide the USPTA with the most outstanding service.

Woods, a USPTA Master Professional, has been a member of the Association for 51 years along with being on the USPTA national board of directors for 13 years serving as president from 2005 - 2007. He attended the University of Houston on a tennis scholarship, was the director of tennis at the Corpus Christi Country Club from 1970 to 2001, and then went on to serve as the executive director for the USPTA Texas Division until 2008. Along with his USPTA membership, he has been a USTA member for his entire tennis playing career and has been a local, section and national volunteer for over 30 years with the organization.

He was responsible for the formation of the USPTA Texas Adult League Championships; the USPTA Texas Champion of Champions event held in conjunction with the U.S. Men's Clay



Court tournament at River Oaks Country Club and the highly successful USTA "Little State" Adult League Championships for second place league teams. He also ran a local Tennis Across America Day for over 20 years in Corpus Christi and was able to bring nationally known teachers and celebrities to the event such as Vijay Amitraj, Vic Braden, Wayne Bryan, Jack Groppe, Jim Loehr, Stan Smith, Fred Stolle, & Gunders Tillmanis. He also spearheaded a \$3 million-dollar bond issue to upgrade the facilities at the HEB & Al Kruse Tennis Centers in Corpus Christi. For this effort, three tennis courts at the HEB Tennis Center were named in his honor.

Ron is most proud of his work with "Tennis Success" - A program that offers tennis, education and college scholarships to underserved youth in his community.

"It is humbling and a great honor to receive the USPTA George Bacso Lifetime Achievement Award," said Woods. "Tennis has been a great vehicle for me to achieve my dreams and meet so many wonderful people involved in the sport and industry. I plan on continuing to give back to the game that has given so much to me."

## Texas Tennis Hall of Fame Inducts Two Newest Members



**O**n Saturday, November 10, the Texas Tennis Museum and Hall of Fame hosted its 2018 Annual Banquet. This year's event, entitled "Love on and off the court!" celebrated Texas tennis families.

Jim Chaffin, secretary/treasurer of the Museum, opened the program and welcomed the guests. Bobby Kleinecke delivered the convocation. After dinner, guests heard from Brian Boland, Director of Tennis and Head Men's Tennis Coach at Baylor University.

The Byrl Clayton, Ted Erck and Dr. Alfredo Treviño families were honored for their contributions to tennis in Texas.

The event culminated with the induction of the 2018 Hall of Fame Class, Jerry Geyman and Bev Taylor. During the induction, a special video of each inductee, produced by USTA Texas, was shown and followed by an introduction of each inductee. The new members of the Hall of Fame were given the chance to say a few words and awarded a certificate, medallion and blue blazer signifying enshrinement into the Texas Tennis Hall of Fame.

**Beverly C. Taylor** has used her passion for tennis to serve her community and greatly impact the lives of those around her. In 1977, Beverly became a league participant of the Houston Ladies Tennis Association. In 1989 she was elected President of the Houston Tennis Association. From 1990 to 1994 she worked as the Coordinator of Volunteers for the Virginia Slims of Houston WTA Event. Taylor also served as the Executive Director of the Linda Lorelle Scholarship Fund/Tennis Classic from 1992-2005.

In addition to her many titles in the tennis community, Taylor has spent countless hours volunteering at tennis tournaments and other events. Since 2008, she has served as the chair of the Houston Tennis Association's National Junior Tennis and Learning chapter (HTA NJTL). Her dedicated leadership to this chapter has resulted in tremendous improvement in free youth tennis and educational programs to thousands of low-income youth in the Houston area. The NJTL serves over 6,000 youth in over 45 neighborhoods and 20 schools, as well as awarding close to \$18,000 in college scholarships annually. She is also currently a member of the HTA Advisory Board.



**Jerry D. Geyman** has dedicated much of his life to the development of tennis in Texas. As a player, Geyman played in and won a number of both professional and amateur tennis events. From 1972 to 1976, Geyman served as the Program and Research Director for World Championship Tennis (WCT) in Dallas. During that time he established 12 WCT tennis academies in the United States and Europe. He also coordinated 12 professional tournaments in international locations, including Sao Paulo, Brazil and Canada.

In addition to numerous other professional achievements, Geyman founded Planning and Management International in Dallas, where he secured Wilson Sporting Goods equipment to Mexico. He was the president until 1982, when he became president of Bentley Village Racquet Club Inc. There he designed and built the Eastchase Sports Club and coordinated numerous pro-celebrity tournaments. He served as president until 1997, when he became president and owner of Sports Concepts of America. Here he has developed multi-sports facilities made primarily out of monolithic dome.

## Jack Foster Inducted to Latin American International Sports Hall of Fame

**J**ack Foster of Sugar Land earned induction to the Latin American International Sports Hall of Fame on Saturday, January 26 in Laredo.

Born at the old Mercy Hospital in downtown Laredo with a birth injury on his right side, Foster had to compensate with his left arm and leg, nevertheless he never let it hold him back. Jack attended Laredo's schools, graduating from Martin High in 1960 and Texas A&M University in 1972. He married the love his life, Millie in 1991 and commenced to build a career in professional tennis. He was a competitive tournament tennis player until being diagnosed in the mid 1990's with a genetic disease known as Alpha -1 Antitrypsin Deficiency. A1AD causes emphysema (not from smoking). He now has less than 50% lung capacity than normal for his age. He is also a bladder cancer survivor. His last tournament was in the men's 55's, some 25 years ago.

In his long and impressive career, Jack has served as a head professional and director of tennis at two locations in the Houston area. He is presently Director of Tennis of Tennis for FCCA, a subdivision of Sugar Land, Texas a tester for potential teaching pros and serves on committees for various organizations, as well as on their head advisory staffs. Foster still remains an active on-court teaching professional. In this capacity, he has dedicated many years to teaching stroke survivors, wheelchair players (USPTA Wheelchair certified), amputee players, autistic children and physically disabled children.

He is a certified USPTA (United States Professional Tennis Association) Professional since 1991, designated a master tennis professional in 2016 (Less than 1% of USPTA professionals out of a total of 15,000 members have achieved that designation), certification tester since 2006, National Star Award Recipient 2005, Texas Division Tester of the Year 2010 and 2012, and George Basco National tester of the Year 2013. A member of PTR (Professional Tennis Registry) since 1996, achieving professional status in 3 pathways, adult, junior and high performance tennis. The organization committees are USTA Adaptive tennis, nominating committee and PTR Education Committees.

He has served on USPTA National Committees for Education, Conference Awards and Diversity Inclusion Committees, as well as their Texas Board of Directors from 2007-2008 and conference chairman for 6 years.

He has been published in professional magazines and newspapers, including the Tennis magazine, USPTA Texas Monthly Advantage Magazine, USPTA Texas Monthly, The Texas Magazine, The USPTA Southwest Division Magazine and many articles and tips on tennis in the Old Houston Post newspaper.

USTA Texas sent five teams to the 2018 Junior Team Tennis National Championships in early November and all five teams returned with hardware.


Dallas Select swept the 14U division, capturing both the Advanced and Intermediate national titles. The ATA Dream Team from Austin Tennis Academy finished second in the Advanced division, falling 47-42 in the championship match.

The very next weekend, the ATA Dream Team won the 18U Advanced National Championship, while the ATA Knightmares finished runner-up in the Intermediate division.


